## Holocaust Jokes And Anti-Semitism At The US Air Force Academy

*A 2004 survey indicated that half the cadets at the academy reported hearing religious slurs on campus. One documented "joke" went like this: "Why do Jews make the best magicians? Because they can go into a building and vanish in a puff of smoke." Jewish cadets complained about being called "Christ-killers" and being told that the Holocaust was revenge for the death of Jesus.*


#### Finishing Strong

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

My name is David Miller, my friends call me Akiva. I was born in 1960 and I spent my early, formative years in rural Iowa. I attended Washington Township Elementary School where I wasn't permitted to touch my lunch until the entire class was seated and all heads were bowed so the teacher could lead us in a Christian prayer. Later my family moved closer to Oxford, Iowa and I attended Cosgrove Elementary for the first half of the third grade, where most of the students were given time off during the school day to attend Catechism in the next door Catholic Church and afterwards returned to the playground where, undeterred by teachers, they physically harassed those brave few who had stayed behind. My family moved to Oregon when I was 8 1/2, and though I returned many times to visit in the years since, I was not prepared for the bigotry and intolerance that awaited me here in Iowa.

Shining the light of day on religious discrimination within the VA is going to be just like turning the light on in a filthy kitchen – the roaches will scramble to find their hiding places in the woodwork. When he was a cadet at the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colo., in the early 1970s, Norton Schwartz did not hide his religion under his blue-and-white uniform.

A member of the academy's Jewish choir before graduating in 1973, according to one of his classmates, Schwartz has since risen up the ranks and on June 9 was appointed Air Force chief by Defense Secretary Robert Gates.

If confirmed by the Senate, Schwartz will be expected to immediately deal with an armed service that has been badly embarrassed by the recent mishandling of nuclear material. But Schwartz, one of only a few Jews in
