Regrettably, I am writing to inform you that your request for a thirty day extension to your move-out date can no longer be accommodated. I have attached a letter that contradicts the information that was available when you and I first discussed this issue.

When you and I met, you had documentation that supported your statement that you would be granted base access through March 2, 2007. I have attached a letter from the United States Navy that states you will not be able to access any military installations after January 31, 2007. Because your home is on base, providing you an extension has become an impossibility. As a result, you will need to follow proper vacate procedures and vacate the home no later than January 31, 2007.
